- **Typography:** Use sans-serif fonts for digital clarity (e.g., Arial or Calibri).
  - *Titles:* 32–40pt.
  - *Body Text:* 24pt minimum.
- **Layout:** Maintain a clean aesthetic with 1-inch margins. Limit text to a maximum of six bullet points per slide to avoid clutter.
- **Media:** Utilize high-resolution images, charts, and graphs. Avoid distracting transitions or excessive animations.

## **2. Presentation Structure**

- **Slide 1: Title Slide**

– Include the full paper title, author names, affiliations, and the conference heading (**ICWPD 2026**).

- **Slide 2: Introduction**

– Define the research problem, significance, and specific objectives/questions.

- **Slide 3: Literature Review**

– Highlight foundational theories and relevant studies using APA 7<sup>th</sup> Edition Style for in-text citations.

- **Slide 4: Methodology**

– Detail the research design, data collection, analytical techniques, and sample size.

- **Slide 5: Results & Analysis**

– Prioritize visual data (graphs/tables) over text to illustrate key findings.

- **Slide 6: Discussion**

– Synthesize findings in the context of existing literature.

- **Slide 7: Conclusion & Recommendations**

– Summarize takeaways, theoretical/practical implications, and study limitations.

- **Slide 8: References**

– List all cited works in APA 7th Format (minimum 18pt font for readability).
